WELCOME to all was extended by Don Schleuse to owners who were able to attend the Open Board Meeting.

CALL TO ORDER

President Don Schleuse called the Board Meeting to order at 9:07 am.

APPROVE MEETING MINUTES

Motion by Max Archer to approve 01-09-24 Open Board Minutes; 2nd by Henry Hays; and, PASSED.

INTEGRA REPORT/FINANCIALS

Tess Allison reported the financial standing through 03-31-24, reflecting the following: Peoples Bank operating account balance \$71,444.39, Heritage Bank operating account balance [laundry income] \$39,821.04, Petty Cash of \$165.34; Edward Jones Reserve account of \$365,304.28 and WECU Activity account of \$3,152.03, for a total bank of \$479,887.08. We are under Budget in expenses thru 03-31-24 by \$17,125.39. Full spring park inspection/tour will be done next week by the board and management. It was a relatively calm winter with the exception of mid-January when temperatures dropped well below freezing and some units experienced broken water lines. The commons buildings weathered well with no damage and thank you to our maintenance personnel who were on top of everything.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Gary Hall reports he continues to monitor the laddered CD's with each CD now earning approximately 5% interest.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

▶ ARCHITECTURAL. Henry Hays reports that so far for 2024 the AC Committee has received 24 architectural request forms with 22-approved and 2-still pending to be resubmitted. Thank you to Daryl Dunn for chairing the committee and all of his work the past couple of months! Please remember that only one (1) request is to be submitted on each form. [Maintenance Report attached]

- ▶ ACTIVITIES. Max Archer reports the Activities Committee continues with hosting Wednesday morning coffee. Attendance is increasing with potlucks and activities as our snowbirds are returning. May potlucks are held every other Friday. Some activities planned for this year are: Pancake Benefit Breakfast for the fire department; karaoke night, MoTown dinner dance, garage sale in August. Check the Activities calendar to view all of the scheduled events.
- ▶ GROUNDS & MAINTENANCE. Henry Hays provided the Maintenance Report [attached] noting the many items our maintenance employees have been working on, including additional maintenance work on the pool remediation project. The exterior pole lighting by the dumpster has been worked on with the fixture being replaced we now have good lighting in this area once again.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

- ▶ Speed Bumps Discussion and scheduling of additional speed bumps in the Park is tabled until 2025.
- ▶ Pool Repairs/Remediation Project Plastering of the pool is being completed this week by KrisCo Pools. The weather temperatures are maintaining at 40 degrees, so this work was able to be scheduled. The pool is scheduled to be filled this week and the Board together with maintenance will work through the night to monitor filling of the pool. Providing the required chemical balancing has been achieved, the pool will be OPEN by June 1st with the hope we are able to open earlier. The pool opening date is contingent on the chemical balancing.

NEW BUSINESS:

- ▶ Spring dumpster Following discussion, it was agreed the disposal dumpster will be brought in on Friday, May 17, 2024 through Monday May 27, 2024. All Park residents must work to ensure compliance with proper disposal rules of items allowed to be dumped in the spring dumpster. Failure to properly dispose of items will result in an immediate \$250/fine being assessed to the offender. New dumpster signage will be ordered.
- ▶ Pool Opening Date Providing the proper and correct level of chemical balancing for the pool is achieved, the target date for opening the pool is June 1st. It is possible the pool will be opened earlier than June 1st if the chemical balancing levels are reached prior to June 1st.
